A note from our classes

Orchard class – The letter sounds we have looked at so far now make some words! We have continued looking at number/quantity in maths and not only do we all have a skeleton with 300 bones when we are born, the smallest one is in our ear! and we have lots of organs inside our skeleton to protect.

Our peaches have been exploring the book 'Things I Like' by Anthony Browne along with games to develop skills and confidence of sharing, discussing and listening within a group, and what we like to do at home and in preschool. We have explored what we all look like, drawing self portraits to create our own "peaches tree" display, continuing to consolidate our group community and sense of belonging.

Oak – We had a fantastic time finding a variety of natural materials in the school grounds to help create our own deciduous trees, using a blank canvas as our backdrop. We designed our own Crest of Arms ready to create next week, and were working very hard on our handwriting. I am so impressed with the children's enthusiasm!

Willow –. We have been solving complex expressions using the < > and = signs and tackled some challenging problems. The children have showed incredible resilience with their maths learning this week. In English we've continued with our core text 'Ug' and used conjunctions to make comparisons between Ug's world and ours. We then applied this to our History learning and went on a village walk to find out how Stone Age people would've survived against threats in the wild and what assets they could use to protect them. Finally, in Science, we've been investigating rocks including our Hornton Ironstone and will continue with this next week!

Rowan –. We have gone from learning Ancient Greek battle formations, to experimenting with magnets then perfecting shading skills in art. As well as this we've been working hard on complex addition and subtraction questions, and exploring how to create mood and atmosphere with their descriptive writing. At the end of the week its been French, learning names of household pets, writing this in a short sentence and playing a fun tactical French number game outside!, finishing off with a fabulous presentation about cricket from one of the children, with a question and answer session. Well done!
