Cricket Club (R-Yr 6)

Tuesday

Musical Theatre Group (R-Yr 6)

Miss Goddard and Mrs Saunders will be running a lively and energetic musical theatre group (Methodist Chapel). If you like singing and drama then this is the club for you. Please wear comfortable clothes. The children will be performing at our Summer Concert in July.

Wednesday

Tennis Club (Yr3-6)
