## **Key Information**

Children should wear their PE uniform to school on Sports day.

- Should the weather be sunny and hot it is vital that children bring sunscreen, hat/cap and have their water bottles.
- The weather may be cool so it is important the children have a sweatshirt to keep them warm.
- Please bring a chair or picnic blanket to watch the event.
- After the event children will be escorted inside by their teachers and school will finish at the normal time of 3.15pm.
- Please park at the far end of the Pavilion car park.
- Should we need to cancel sports day due to weather we will contact you via email at 8.00am.
- Photography as some pupils parents have not given permission for their child to be photographed it means NO photographs/Videos to be taken.
- There will be a parent race so start training!
