Monday-

Tuesday-

Wednesday

Junior Citizen Trip- The children in Year 6 travelled by train to the the Ashmolean Museum and Oxford Fire Station.

During their visit all children experience eight different safety scenarios and each child is given the opportunity to practice making a 999 telephone call. The children are taught a variety of life skills which focus upon how to keep themselves safe whilst potentially helping others who may be in difficulty or distress.
