#### World Book Day

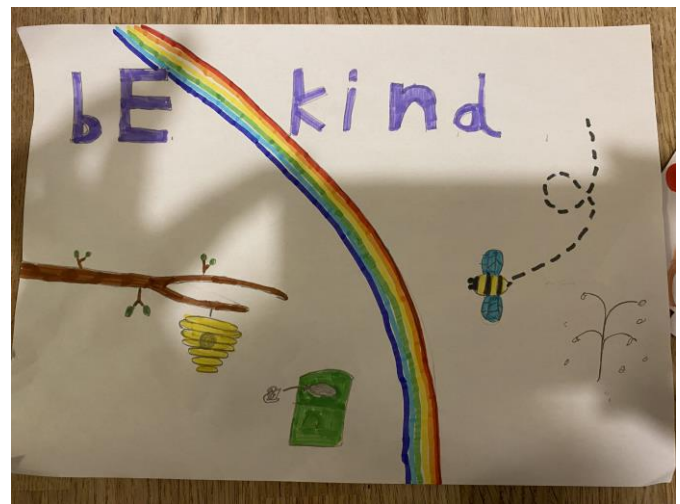
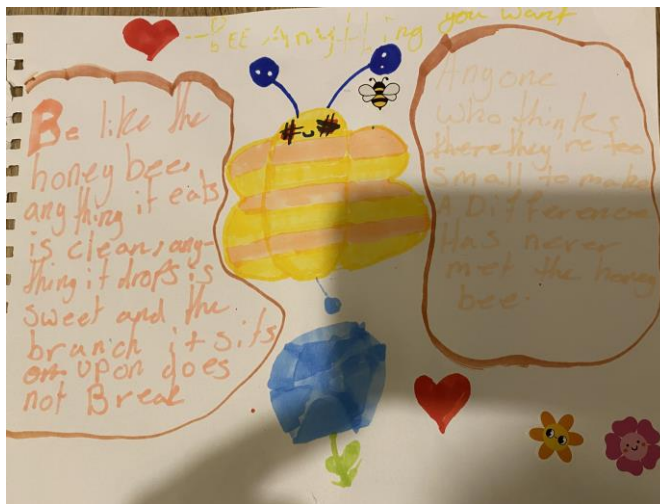
