Mr Runcorn has organised for a History Drama company to come and work with our children on the 5th of June. During the class-by-class sessions, each group will help a Time Traveller navigate their way back through time while exploring their chosen topic (Rowan - Ancient Maya, Willow - Anglo Saxons and Oak - Great Fire of London. Children will reimagine the life and times of that period, gather key information and facts, and consider how it might have felt to be a person living through that time. Using theatrical techniques, they will also consider the topic within a historical timeline and, finally, discuss its legacy.

- To think critically about the topic by experiencing it first-hand.
- To understand what came before and after the historical period you are exploring.
- To walk in the shoes of the people in your chosen historical period and to consider how their achievements impacted the world.
- To develop creative ownership and imagination by working alongside a professional actor-facilitator.
- To explore different ways of communicating, both verbally and physically.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.00 towards the cost of the workshop. Our usual charging policy applies to this event and, while no individual child will be excluded from participating, if not enough contributions are received the workshop may not go ahead.

It will take place at the Pavilion but please collect your child from school as usual.
