Music Concert Friday 15th July - If your child takes part in music lessons in the school there will be a short concert during the afternoon of the 15th July. This will take place in the church and will start at 2.00pm. The children are looking forward to sharing the pieces they have been practicing this term (please note this also includes the children who are learning the recorder with Mrs Payne.)

Homework Survey - We are planning to have a new Homework Policy for the beginning of the new academic year. As you will no doubt be aware, the most complex issue with homework is the range of differing views around what it should look like for your own children. It will be incredibly hard to suit everyone, but with your views, we hope we can provide a policy which takes everyone's ideas into account. Please return your answers by the end of term.

On Wednesday the 13th July, we will be holding our **Changing bodies workshop with Year 5 and 6 pupils**. To support our discussion and question and answer sessions we are intending to use the SCARF PSHE materials, which is the scheme, used across our Multi Academy trust. An overview of the objectives are included in our PSHE/RSE policy, which is on our school website. The year groups will be split into specific year groups. The lessons concentrate on the changes that occur during puberty (Year 5), reproduction, pregnancy and birth (Year 6). Mrs Pollock, a midwife, is also going to be visiting Year 6 to answer any questions.

If you have any questions about the programme being followed, please see Mr Runcorn. Sex Education is part of the National Curriculum. However, if you do not want your child to take part in these lessons please let me know by letter as soon as possible.

Parking - As we all know, we have limited parking available in the immediate vicinity of the school. There is ample parking availability at the Pavilion, from where it is a short and pleasant walk to the school.
